- Craig will be offering the NRA Range Safety Officer class to club members at a reduced rate. Anyone interested please contact one of the club officers.
- Volunteer's to oversee the installation of insulation in the meeting room are needed. If you can be at the range while the workers are there please contact one of the officers.
- Work on the indoor range to replace paneling will occur the second week in January, if you can come out and help please contact Tim Drum.
- Tim reminds members that in the 50 yard pistol bay no rounds may impact the ground before the 25 yard marker.
- All members will be required to present proof of a current NRA membership before receiving a key for the new year.
- Due to the ongoing misuse of the range and damage to property the officer team has recommended use of a log book for the immediate future until additional cameras can be installed. All members and guest will have to sign in and out. A motion was made and passed to move forward with the recommendation. After the log book has been put up the club will be informed of the procedure for logging in and out and the consequences for failing to do so.
