I hope everybody is doing well. Here is a brief update of what is going on at CVRPC:

No club meeting in December –as seems to be the normal procedure these days but there will **not** be a regular club meeting on Thursday December 3. Please spread the word. I know there are several applicants waiting to have the opportunity to petition to join our club but we need to be able to have a regular club meeting to do this and with the current circumstances we just don't know when that will be. If you are a sponsor to someone that has applied to CVRPC, please continue to bring them as your guest, they are welcome. The more you bring them, the more members they will get to meet and the more they will get to learn how things work around our club.

Roof – the roof structure of the club house has been inspected by a Professional Engineer and found to be sound enough to support a new roof. Bids are to be solicited for a new metal roof and any required repairs.

Damaged Fence – the tree that fell across the fence at the front gate has been removed. Whoever did this work, thank you! A local fence company had been contacted about doing the repairs but they don't seem to want to return calls. More bids are being submitted.

Bridges – both bridges washed into the creek during these last heavy rains. If you didn't get to see it, both the metal bridge and the new wooden foot bridge ended up at the bend in the creek at the left side of the Rifle Range. The metal bridge has been set back in place and the foot bridge will be back soon for use, if not already back. Thank you Bryan Miller and crew for the great work! Options are being considered to see what can be done with the foot bridge to get it up higher out of any potential flood waters.

Looking to 2021 – the following matches for 2021 have been approved. Check the club calendar:

AR Fun Match- March 13, May 8, July 10, September 11. 100, 200 ,300 rifle ranges closed during these matches.

.22 Table Top – April 17, May 15, June 19, July 17, August 21. 200, 300 ranges closed during these matches.

.22 TSC – April 10, June 12, August 14, October 9. 10, 200, 300 and skeet range closed during these matches.



3Gun – March 6, April 4, May 1, June 5, July 3, August 7, September 4, October 2, November 6, December 4. All pistol bays will be closed for these matches. Shotgun Range will be closed depending on stage requirement.

High Power Rifle – March 3, April 4, May 1, September 4, October 2, November 6. Rifle Ranges closed during these matches.

Defensive Pistol – 3rd Sunday of each month January thru December. Pistol Bay 1 will be closed for these matches.

Winter League- from Ed Rosamond:

As everyone knows, we didn't get to finish the 2020 league due to the sudden influx of Covid-19 restrictions placed upon North Carolina. We had planned to finish this past summer, but did not due to the ongoing restrictions that were never lifted enough to allow for an indoor match. Current plans, providing Covid restrictions allow for it, are to host practice sessions on 17 December, 30 Dec, and 7 January. The official match season will run for 10 weeks beginning 14 Jan and run thru 17 March. All matches and practice sessions will begin at 6pm each Thursday evening. We will shoot 2 matches per night, with the exception of the Thursday nights of club meetings. On those nights we will only shoot one match.
