Meeting was called to order by club president Michael Hollar at 7:35pm.

Guest in attendance were: Billy Christenberry 3rd meeting, John Nain, Shane Huston and Mark Stafford 1st meeting.

Old business:

- Regarding changing wording of Article 9 of By Laws, the club officers have not been able to meet.
- Closing in the right side of 100 yard range firing area is near completion and looks great.
- It will be fall of this year before contractor can start replacing the roof on the clubhouse.

New Business:

- Dates of 6/30, 7/14, 7/21, 7/28, 8/4 and 8/11 were requested for use of the Pistol and Shotgun Ranges by 4H. These dates were approved.
- Vice President Tim Drum reported that he has collected over \$450 from the cash box located at the Skeet Range. It seems that program of putting money in the box at the time members shoot skeet is working well.
- Tim Drum mentioned that there is a trashcan located at the Skeet Range for empty shotshell hulls and that members are not to put their empty hulls in the burn barrels.
- Ken O’Neal encouraged members to come out to the club and shoot on July 4th.
- Dick Blumenstein encouraged any perspective members to come out to matches and events held at CVRPC.
- Vice President Tim Drum mentioned his appreciation to all that have been mowing around the ranges and property.
- Gary Houser made mention that the battery is weak/dead on the 4 wheeler and it will not hold a charge.
- To clarify the intention of Article IX of the club By Laws, Ken O’Neal made a motion, and it was seconded, to change the wording to read (highlighted wording has been added):

Any proposed amendments to these by-laws may be introduced by any member of the club at any regular meeting or special meeting called for the purpose. They must be acted upon at a meeting called for the purpose, provided a copy of the amendment has been presented to each club member by electronic means, posted on the club website and posted in the clubhouse at least ten (10) days previous to the meeting. A two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members present will be necessary to pass or reject it.

This proposed change will be addressed at the August club meeting.
