The meeting opened at 7:30PM. The June minutes were read and approved. The June 2010 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. (Balance brought forward was \$44,121.71, deposits were \$3189.25 and disbursements for the month totaled \$216.69. Ending balance was \$47,094.27. There were no guests at this meeting.

Old Business:

- The two Cyprus trees that were crowding the gate have been removed and burned.
- No progress has been made yet on replacing the sagging bridge, but Ronny and Bryan Miller will discuss the options soon.

New Business:

- The treasurer has a list of hours worked and meetings attended. See John for necessary corrections. The club was reminded that all claimed work hours must be in by Dec. 31st.
- The treasurer reported that 14 existing members from last year have not yet paid 2010 dues.
- Ronny reminded the membership of the Work Parties each 2nd Thursday, starting at 4PM.
- Joe Lassiter pointed out that the asphalt on the 200 yard firing line is badly cracked. He offered to patch the cracks and a motion was passed to provide up to \$200 funding for the materials.
- Ronny showed the membership the recently abused ram swinger target and pointed out 29 individual bullet pock marks in the metal. It is believed that the damage happened on or about Wednesday, June 30th. Apparently, a small caliber high-velocity weapon was used, possibly firing metal piercing rounds, which are against club rules for use on metal targets. Any club member caught damaging targets in this way will be expelled from the club.
- A discussion followed on what can be done to prevent this sort of thing from happening, with the general opinion expressed that we need to improve monitoring of the entrance gate. Ronny will follow up with possible solutions to getting the camera system updated.
- The Land Assessment payment is due September 15th. At current interest rates and membership levels, Ronny believes that we can pay this off by 2015.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:07 PM.
