The meeting opened at 7:30PM. The October minutes were read and approved. The October 2010 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. (Balance brought forward was \$10,787.12, deposits were \$2,827 and disbursements for the month totaled \$1,265.05. Ending balance was \$12,349.07. Chuck Miller was a guest, attending his first meeting this month.

Old

- The wind flags have been obtained and a sample was on display at the meeting. The holes have been dug and the supporting pipes set in place, but the poles have not yet been placed in the pipes.
- The bridge issue has not yet been settled, but Bryan Miller said he had access to a free 8' wide trailer bed and would see if this would be suitable as a bridge deck. Cement pipes remain as an option, but there is no decision on this yet.

New :

- Norm reported that the F-class 300 yard high power match mentioned at the October meeting has been re-scheduled for Saturday, December 4th. A flyer for the match was passed out at this meeting, and further details are on the club's web page.
- Ronnie reported that the yearly all-around match would be held on the second and third Saturdays in January for rifle and then on the second and third Saturdays in February for shotgun and pistol.
- Lonnie reported that the indoor .22 rimfire bullseye matches will start on January 6th, 2011 at 6PM. Subsequent matches will be held each Thursday, January through March. Practice matches will be held each Thursday in December.
- Steve reported that 14 shooters competed in the first Rimfire Extreme tactical match, and that 19 shooters were already signed up for the next match. Pay-off is 40% of the proceeds for first place, 20% for second and 10% for third place, with the remaining 30% going to the club to cover expenses. There is a growing "jackpot", currently totaling \$110, that will be awarded to anyone shooting a perfect score. The remaining matches for the year will be held November 13th and December 11th. Details are on the club website.
- Neil reported that the annual Bunker Hill shooting program will begin in February on Tuesdays, late afternoon/early evenings. He added that there may be some sessions held in January, but that wasn't clear yet.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:49 PM.
