The meeting opened at 7:31PM. The September minutes were read and approved. The September 2010 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. (Balance brought forward was \$47,243.76, deposits were \$30.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$36,375. Ending balance was \$10,787.12. The treasurer further reported that we have 125 members, with 47 of those being senior members, thus there are 47 openings. John Barnette was a guest, attending his third meeting this month, and was voted into the club unanimously. Welcome John!

Old Business:

- We are still undecided on the bridge replacement. We can get a 10' by 20' culvert for about \$2400, plus probably \$600 to install it. We will probably need a headwall installed as well. Ronnie will talk with Bryan Miller about this and report at the next meeting.
- We are still waiting on more quotes for the camera upgrades.
- The last High Power match had 18 shooters each day, and we received some good comments from Dick Whiting, who is an NRA rep. This should net the club about \$400. Thanks George!
- IHMSA competition is over for the year.

New Business:

- An F-class 300 yard high power match was proposed for the 1st Saturday in November. The Buffalo shooters will be asked if this will interfere with their matches or not. There will be 80 rounds fired, plus sighters. Registration is at 8A with the match to start by 9A.
- Randy reported that there will be a concealed carry class held on October 30th.
- Installation of three Wind Flags was proposed for the long range rifle course, to be installed between the 100 meter and 300 yard lines, at an anticipated cost of about \$450. The motion carried.
- The "Extreme 22 Silhouette Tactical" match was further discussed, with advice given that at least 27 minutes of elevation change would be required between the nearest and farthest targets. Rules and further details for the match are on the website.
- The membership is reminded that they are responsible for each guest they bring to the range. Do not allow guests to shoot on their own without supervision.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:18 PM.
