The meeting opened at 7:30PM. The August minutes were read and approved, however Ronnie advised that the Land Loan will be paid off in 2014, not 2015 as reported in the minutes. The August 2010 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. (Balance brought forward was \$46,649.72, deposits were \$763.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$168.96. Ending balance was \$47,243.76. John Barnette was a guest, attending his second meeting this month, along with Dan Goss and Arthur Hayes, attending their first meetings.

Old Business:

- The bridge repair is still under consideration. We are still looking for a ~10' diameter fuel tank to use as the basis for a culvert.
- Another quote has been received for a replacement camera security system. "Security Systems Direct" has quoted one hi-res camera (capable of reading license plates), one normal-res camera, a computer with 1TB storage (30-35 days) plus cabling, for \$1400. Trenching will be extra. Prospective member Dan Goss will check with "Atwood Security Systems" to get another quote and report at a future meeting.
- Bob Metts has been working on the wobble trap and has solved several problems. He still needs some parts, but is making progress.

New Business:

- George Northam presented a proposal to install new High-power firing point markers, which passed unanimously. The State Championship High-Power match will be held at out range on October 2nd and 3rd.
- The last scheduled work party will be held on Thursday, September 9th. Everyone is asked to attend if possible.
- The last IHMSA Silhouette matches for the year will be held this month.
- Ronnie presented a motion that we host "Extreme 22 Silhouette Tactical" matches on the second Saturday of the months of October, November and December this year. The motion was unanimously approved. Details will follow, but it is anticipated that lightweight steel plate targets will be placed at 50, 100, 150 and 200 meters and shot from several positions. Entry fees will probably be \$10-15, with the club retaining 30% for expenses, etc.
- The land payment we are making this year will be almost twice what is required by the loan agreement, thus moving us closer to the 2014 pay-off.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:57 PM.
