The meeting opened at 7:29PM, with VP Sam Birchfield presiding. The July minutes were read and approved. The July 2011 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$43,120.59, deposits were \$2,468 and disbursements for the month totaled \$3,061.06. Ending balance was \$42,527.53. The treasurer also reported that there are now 9 members from last year that have not paid their 2011 dues. Guests this month were Bill Redmond, 4th meeting, Frank Allisio, third meeting, David Gordon, Tom Johansen and Don Herot, second meeting, Chuck Johnson, Justin and Caleb Morrison, first meeting. New members Frank Elessio and Bill Redmond were voted in at this meeting - welcome gentlemen!

Old Business: The secretary reported that a paper target order has been made, totaling \$786. A vote was held on the Executive committee recommendations from May of this year, whereby:

1. New members coming in after April of 2012 will be assessed a land assessment of \$300 per year for 5 years, regardless of the land purchase loan payment status.
2. A new member must wait 1 full year before sponsoring any other new members.

These 2 recommendations were passed unanimously. The subject of senior dues was also discussed by the Executive board, but since there was no change recommended, no vote was required by the membership.

New Business:

- The secretary will review any existing documentation on “how to become a member of CVRPC” and will update the document as necessary for discussion at a future meeting. After discussion, the updated information will be posted on the club's website.
- Sam reminded members that there will be a work party next Thursday, starting at 5PM. There is a lot of mowing to be done, so attendees are requested to bring string trimmers and mowers if possible.
- There will be a 22 TSC championship meet on August 13th, with a practice session on the 12th starting at noon. Participation will be limited to the first 50 shooters signing up.
- Randy has requested the use of the pistol range for a concealed carry class on Thursday evening, 8/18. The clubhouse will not be needed for this class, which is composed of members of the Emmanuel Baptist Church.
- There will be an F-Class regional championship match on the 27th and 28th of this month, known as the “Lucas Elliot” match. There will be a discussion at a future meeting regarding possible donation of a percentage of the profits from this match.
- The membership discussed purchasing two new string trimmers for range use, but this was postponed until the President returns next month.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 PM.
