The meeting opened at 7:30PM. The May minutes were read and approved. The May 2011 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$19,577.88, deposits were \$22,177.50 and disbursements for the month totaled \$658.20. Ending balance was \$41,097.18. The treasurer also presented a membership report as follows: Total Members – 115, Total “regular” members – 71, Open Regular Memberships Available – 54, plus other details. Visitors this month were John Dufseth, Michael Greco and William Redmond, all attending their second meeting, with Steve Wright and Frank Alessio both attending their first meeting. Previous member John Murta rejoined the club after a protracted illness – welcome back John!

Old Business: Bryan Miller is still working on the new parking area behind the 300 yard firing line. Rob Holland fixed the plate stands – thanks Rob! Thanks also to Shannon Lyndon for the great time had at Riverview Sports “manufacturer’s day” held at our range in May. Joe Lassiter reported that the 200 yd. line asphalt has been sealed and recoated.

New Business:

- Ronnie will need help hauling the replacement clay pigeon targets after delivery.
- Members are encouraged to make the work parties each 2nd Thursday – projects needing attention are Tree cutting and log splitting, resetting the steel targets at the right side of the Ram berm, fixing the roof of the club house and of course lawn mowing.
- The results of the executive committee meeting were announced (see separate minutes for details). Basically, it is recommended that 1) all new members joining the club after April of 2012 will be required to pay a \$300/yr land assessment for a period of 5 years, irrespective of when the current mortgage is paid off, 2) A new member must wait 1 full year before sponsoring other new members into the club and 3) Senior members 62 years of age and with 20 years of membership in the club will continue to enjoy free membership status. This recommendation will be voted on at the regular August meeting.
- Norm Goezler reminded the members of the F-class meet, scheduled for June 25th. Details are on the club’s website.
- Steve Roe announced that there will be a 22 Tactical Championship match held on the 2nd Saturday in August (8/13) with first place prize money of \$250 minimum. First through fifth places will be awarded prize money, with first place through 3rd place medals for Juniors. Details are on the club’s website.
- There will be a Buffalo Match held the first Saturday as usual.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:12 PM.
