The meeting opened at 7:30PM. The February minutes were read and approved. The February 2011 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Old Business: The gravel spreading has been completed as contracted, and the bridge work is finished. Forty-one shooters have signed up for the tactical 22 match. The safety walk-around must also be completed prior to being voted on.
