**December 6, 2012 (corrected version)**

The meeting opened at 7:30PM. The November minutes were read and approved. The November 2012 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$8,502.90, deposits were \$3,383.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$533.11. Ending balance was \$11,352.79. The treasurer further reported that there are 130 total members, 54 of which are seniors and 76 are "regular" members, leaving 49 openings. Guests this month are Kenneth Parker, third meeting, Donovan Douglas, 2nd. meeting and Don Alexander, Mark Phillips, Bob Banto Sr., Bob Banto Jr., and Wayne Cothran, all attending their first meetings. Subsequently, Kenneth Parker was voted into membership. Welcome Ken!

**OB:** The gravel work has been completed for the year, and over 400 Empty Chamber Indicators have been made. All match Directors are reminded that they should make sure that the website is updated with the latest match info.

**NB:** Ronny made a motion to hold the all-around championship on the 2nd and 3rd Saturdays of January and February, 2013. This was approved by the membership. Norm Goetzler reminded everyone of the Benchrest matches to be held at the newly refurbished 300 yard line on the third Saturdays in March through November, 2013, starting at 9AM. A discussion was held regarding maintaining good traffic flow to the pistol and skeet ranges during these matches. Tim Drum advised the club that we will likely need to purchase additional paper targets for upcoming matches, and since we can get a 50% discount on orders over \$1000, it will be necessary for the match directors to consolidate the order to take advantage of the discount. There is a need for a sledge hammer to be used for pounding in target stakes, which Ronny agreed to obtain for the club. Gary Hauser has repaired the doors to the target houses on the skeet range - thanks Gary! Ronny advised that due to the grading work done at the 200 yard line, power has been interrupted there. He suggested that running new underground lines to the 200 and 300 yard line covers and pistol ranges would be a good idea, and Glenn Shell will provide an estimate for trenching and materials. (The pistol range can be powered from the Skeet range, but some new trenching will be required.)

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15PM.
