**June 7, 2012**

The meeting opened at 7:30PM. The May minutes were read and approved. The May 2012 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$27,918.51, deposits were \$21,627 and disbursements for the month totaled \$369.99. Ending balance was \$49,175.52. Guests this month are Joel Kunze, first meeting, Jim Bentley and Bill Howell, second meeting.

OB: A new weed eater has been purchased from Claremont Hardware, and they would like us to consider them as a possible "supporter" of the club in exchange for advertising on our website. The membership had no objection to this, and Ronny will discuss it further with them and report back. Bryan Miller has started excavating a parking area behind the 200 meter firing line in exchange for use of the dirt that is removed in the process. Ronny reported that the forestry service has inspected the dead trees on the left edge of the 100 yard line and did not find any cause related to insects. They think the problem might be due to a lightning strike. A discussion followed regarding removal and sale of the dead trees, but it was felt that this would expose the range to view from the nearby Rifle Range Road. It would also increase the possibility of a round escaping the range. It was decided therefore to let nature take its course for now and no further action is planned. Ronny further reported that Ken Vaughn will continue as our webmaster.

NB: Projected land payment and operating costs through the end of this fiscal year are \$41,500, meaning that we should have approximately \$8,000 to spend on projects and repairs. We expect now that we will need to spread about 4 truckloads of gravel in various areas at a cost of about \$600 per load. In addition, there has been some talk regarding expansion of the 300 yard firing line cover along with the expansion of the concrete base, expected to cost about \$2300. It was decided to defer the decision on this until the July meeting. In addition to these projects, the clubhouse roof continues to leak, and will need repair soon in order to limit damage to the ceiling in the meeting room.

George Northam requested that we change the 300 yard HP State Championship match from September 22nd and 23rd to September 29th and 30th. This was approved. Also, if anyone is interested in participating in this year's Tuesday evening and Sunday afternoon skeet league, please contact Duran Lail or Sam Birchfield. Finally, there is some chance that we might "inherit" some of the used office furniture from "Classic Leather" as a result of their recent office move.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:02 PM.
