The monthly meeting of CVRP began at 7:30 with President Randy Clark presiding. The minutes were read and approved. The treasurers report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$54,091.64, deposits were \$481.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$895.67. Ending balance was \$53,676.97. Guests this month were Keith Harper, first meeting, Richard Parris, second meeting and Alan Yancey, third meeting. Subsequently, Alan was voted back into membership. Welcome to the club, Alan!

Old Business : The Leyland Cyprus trees have been trimmed and removed as planned. Thanks to all that helped with the project.

New Business : Alan Yancey of Lake Hickory Security has offered to donate a video recorder and monitor if we will buy the necessary cameras. A discussion followed and it was determined that we will need a high resolution camera with a telephoto lens to cover the gate, plus a second camera with a wide angle lens to determine which direction people go once they are on the property. A motion was unanimously passed to budget up to \$750 for this expenditure.

Tim Drum once again called our attention to the damage being done to the steel targets by firing on them with rifle caliber rounds. Tim suggested that at a future meeting we might want to discuss banning the use of rifles on the 2700 range altogether. Ronnie reviewed his discussions with Bryan Miller regarding the state of the earth moving work being done to provide parking space at the 200 meter firing line, plus other recommended work needed to increase the height of the berms along the back roadway and to improve drainage. After review of the drawings Ronnie supplied, a motion was passed to provide funding in the amount of \$3700 to add River sand in the parking area and to finish the additional earth moving work as discussed by around March 1st of 2014. Additional discussion was held regarding the possible addition of a new gate at the end of the 100 yard firing line by the refreshment stand, but this idea was tabled pending review by committee. Harold Wilson offered to determine what hardware was required to refurbish the targets stationed in the 300 yard pits and to provide a report at a future meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:35PM
