The monthly meeting of CVRCP began at 7:30 with President Randy Clark presiding, The minutes were read and approved. The treasurers report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$20,255.17, deposits were \$1,311.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$493.58. Ending balance was \$21,072.59. The treasurer further reported that the work hours sheet is posted on the bulletin board and reminded the members to list any work hours before the end of the calendar year. Guests this month were Michael Charles, first meeting, and Jeff Keller, who is a former member and was subsequently voted back into membership. Welcome back Jeff!

Old Business : Ronnie has volunteered to once again run the club's all-around championship in 2014. The rifle portion of the match will be held the second and third Saturdays in January, with the pistol and shotgun series to be held on the second and third Saturdays in February. The rifle match will be a stand-alone match on the second and third Saturdays in January, but the pistol and shotgun matches will be combined on the second Saturday and repeated on the third Saturday in February. The 300 yard rifle range, along with the middle pistol range and the shotgun range will be closed on the above mentioned Saturdays, starting at 9:30, with the matches to begin at 10A. The duration of the matches will depend on the number of contestants each day. Doug Wisnant of Duke power has advised us that they can install a higher power pole (40') on one side of the rifle range which should help to eliminate future bullet strikes on the power line. This will cost in the area of \$1200, and was approved by unanimous vote of the membership.

New Business : Keith Harper provided proof of license and insurance coverage for the club to support his request to hold Concealed Carry and other for-profit classes on club property as earlier approved by vote of the membership. Ben Smith also provided proof that CVRCP was named as insured on his insurance policy, but has not requested any dates for running classes on club property. Lonnie announced practice for the Bullseye league has started on the indoor range and will continue through March on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. The previously approved FAA team practice will be starting on the first Tuesday in January and will also be using the indoor range. We agreed that the Bullseye shooters will cooperate by delaying the start of their matches on those Tuesdays that the FAA shooters need to be indoors for their sessions.

A discussion was held regarding CVRCP member Ben Smith's practice of holding for-profit classes on club property without prior approval of the membership and also without any payment to the club for non-member students who attended. When asked about this directly, Ben stated that yes, he had held classes, but was not aware that any payments were due the club. He further stated that he did not feel that he owed the club any money for this, even though it was pointed out to Ben that these requirements were clearly stated in the March 7th 2013 meeting minutes.

Additional somewhat heated discussion was held, but no final resolution was reached on the matter.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:25PM
