**January 3, 2013**

The meeting opened at 7:31PM. The November minutes were read and approved. The December 2012 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$11,352.79, deposits were \$528.50 and disbursements for the month totaled \$792.24. Ending balance was \$11,089.05. The treasurer further reported that as of December 31st., 2012, there are 131 total members, 55 of which are seniors and 76 are "regular" members, leaving 49 openings. Five members resigned in 2012 and eleven new members were added. Guests this month are Don Alexander, Mark Phillips, Wayne Cothran and Ralph Maxwell, all attending their second meetings, plus Tom Winslow, attending his first meeting.

**OB:** Ronny has purchased two splitting mauls to be kept at the 200 meter firing line and in the shed at the pistol range. Match director cost reporting sheets have been printed out and are in the file cabinet in the meeting room. Cost estimates for the powering of the 200m, 300 yard and pistol range covered firing lines has been estimated to be about \$1500, and a motion was approved to move forward with the work.

**NB:** Thanks to Lee Hines, Bryan Miller and others for the work done spreading gravel at the covered firing lines. Neil Sipe reported that the Bunker Hill FFA group will once again be holding match practice sessions at the skeet and indoor pistol ranges between 4 and 6PM every Tuesday, January through March 2013. George Northam reported that he will present the High Power income and receipts at the next monthly meeting. Blake Eckard reported that there will be the first Black Powder match held this coming Saturday at 10AM. Ronny reminded the members that the all-around matches will begin with rifle competition on the second and third Saturdays in January, starting at 10AM.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50PM.
