The monthly meeting of CVRP began at 7:30 with President Randy Clark presiding. The minutes were read and approved. The treasurers report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$25,448.94, deposits were \$\$27,197.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$350.17. Ending balance was \$52,295.77. Guests this month were James Norman first meeting, Richard Parris first meeting, Ed Roseman first meeting, Nate Bumgarner first meeting and former member Hewitt Drum, third meeting.

Old Business : A work party was held on May 9th and was a big success. The next work party is set for June 13th at 4:00 until dark.

New Business : Randy ask everyone to check addresses and phone numbers with the treasurer. 22TSC will be on June 8th and set up will be on Friday around 4:00PM. Norman explained F-class bench rest. A discussion started about the next meeting falling on July the 4th, but the membership decided to meet anyway. Joe reported that the next center fire 2 gun speed match will be on July 6th. Tim Drum reported that a trash can will be placed at the skeet range for fired shot shells, and that there will be no walk around training in July.

Hits have been noted on the center disk of the Texas star. Since this will damage the machine, please avoid this situation. A request for an air compressor went out and Gary Houser donated one - Thanks Gary. A discussion on the trees at the skeet field ended with a decision to trim back the limbs. Randy started a discussion about the fact that people who use the range for monetary gain should have their own liability insurance in the amount of 1,000,000 dollars, and it should be on file with the club. A debate followed as to whether the club should be named as co insured. A committee comprised of David Bailey, Sam Birchfield and Steve Roe was formed to study and bring back a recommendation. A discussion on returning members being accepted back into membership resulted in the following being passed:

1. Ex-members in good standing may rejoin after the safety walk around and a club vote.
2. The re-entering member must pay a total of 5 years land payment at 300.00/yr. This could be a total of past payments on the land and remaining future payments. If he joins in 2013 or 2014 then he must complete the land payment he owes. Subsequently, Hewitt Drum was voted back into membership in the club. Welcome back Hewitt.
