The meeting opened at 7:29PM. The November minutes were read and approved with several minor corrections. The February 2013 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$10,041.91, deposits were \$1,873.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$2,997.72. Ending balance was \$8,917.19. Guests this month are Keith Lynch, Dale Flinchum, Hewitt Drum, Eric Miller and Ralph Maxwell, all attending their second meetings, plus Donavan Douglas, 3rd meeting and Wayne Cothran, 4th meeting. Subsequently Donavan and Wayne were voted into the club. Welcome gentlemen!

OB: Ronny announced that the April general membership meeting and dinner will be hosted again this year by Catawba Methodist Church at 7PM on April 4th. All regular and prospective members and their significant others are encouraged to attend.

NB: Ronny proposed changes to Range Rule number 11, defining target placement on the 2700 pistol ranges. These changes were approved by the membership and will be included in an update presented at the next club meeting. In addition, the membership voted to outlaw the use of Tannerite explosive targets, and this provision will be added to range rule 15. Furthermore, an additional potential rule change covering so-called "bump fire" devices will be discussed amongst volunteer club members George Northam, Joe Lassiter, Tim Drum and David Weiss, with a recommendation to follow. Club members are reminded that the first .22TSC match will be April 9th. Norm Goetzler presented Harold Wilson with a first place trophy for winning the 300 yard BR competition last year. These matches will resume on the third Saturdays, starting in March and extending into December. In addition, F-Class matches will resume on the 4th Saturdays of each month. Joe Lassiter announced that he has re-hung some of the round steel armor plates at various locations on new rubber hangers. Please let Joe know how this works out in comparison with the previously used chain hangers. Tim Drum announced that the .22 Steel challenge matches will resume on the 3rd Saturday in April. He is considering reducing the number of rounds fired in the match due to the current .22 ammo shortage. Ronny was advised that we were out of clay pigeons - replacements will be ordered. Finally, the club voted on and approved the requirement that all "for profit" classes held at our facilities shall result in a \$10 payment to the treasury for each non-member attendee. This fee is to cover the use of club facilities.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 PM.
