The meeting was called to order at 7:32 by our newly elected president, Randy Clark. The April meeting minutes were read and approved. The April 2013 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$11,621.19, deposits were \$16,720.40 and disbursements for the month totaled \$2,767.75. Ending balance was \$25,573.84. Guests this month were Jeff Thornburg and Paul Spargo, 1st meeting, Ralph Maxwell and Dale Flinchum, 3rd meeting. Subsequently, Ralph and Dale were voted into the club. Welcome gentlemen!

OB: The most recent range rule changes regarding the 2700 range were read and accepted, and will be posted on the website. The so-called "bump fire" committee gave their report and suggestion for how to word the intended exclusion of such devices. Discussion followed, and it was determined that the suggestions made were too vague. As a member of the committee, David Weiss volunteered to provide the club with a written version of the outcome of the membership discussion on the subject to be included in a future update to the range rules.

NB: Black Powder Cartridge Rifle competition at 200 yards was approved for June 1, Aug 3, October 5, Nov 2 and Dec 7. The ERO displayed some of the newly refurbished metal targets from the 2700 range that had already been dimpled by rifle fire. The members were once again reminded not to hit these targets with bottle necked cartridges. It was announced that new lightweight steel plates for the Texas Star target system have been made, and the members are cautioned to only use these new plates with .22LR rimfire ammunition. The ERO received approval to purchase new trash cans for the range. Randy announced that work parties will be held on the second Thursdays of May through September, and all ranges will be closed from late afternoon through dark on those days. A motion was approved to once again look into providing cameras to at least monitor the entrance, and possibly other areas. Randy will handle this, but meanwhile, all members should attempt to get the tag numbers of anyone seen violating a range rule. The TGAC competition will take place the first Saturday this month between 9:30A and 1:30P on the 2700 range. Finally, it was announced that the Bunker Hill Boys placed 3rd overall in the FFA Team Matches.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:27 PM.
