**Old Business :** Our Executive Range Officer reported that there are classes being conducted at the range without prior approval of the membership and without the instructor's insurance policy specifically naming the club as being insured. This will be further discussed at the next meeting.

**New Business :** George Northam presented the HP results for the year and announced that the net to the club will be \$1010. Congratulations and thanks George! Joe Lassiter reported that the target cart for the pistol range has been acquired. He advised that the next TGAC match will be December 7th, and matches will be held through the winter on the first Saturdays of December through March, 2014.

Ronnie Brown polled the members present to see if there is sufficient interest in holding an all-around match next year. He will announce his intentions at the next meeting. Berm work near the 200m and 300 yard lines continues by Bryan Miller. New member Keith Harper requested and received permission to teach CCW and Personal Protection classes using club facilities on Saturday, December 14th, and January 18th, all with proper insurance coverage for the club.

The overhead power line above the 300 yard range has been accidentally partially damaged by gunfire, but is still working. Discussions were held on what we should do to fix it, but for now it is assumed that it will be trenched instead of re-strung, depending on costs.
