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**December 4, 2014**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club president, Randy Clark. The November meeting minutes were read and approved. The November, 2014 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$22,755.57, deposits were \$1,490.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$1,035.64. Ending balance was \$23,209.93. Guests this month were Crystal Setzer – 1<sup>st</sup> meeting; Teddy Smith, Dale Mitchell – 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting. Teddy Smith and Dale Mitchell were voted into membership. Welcome gentlemen!

### Old Business:

- The steel plate rack is awaiting two additional plates to complete the repairs however it is fully functional.
- Bob Metz advised the parts to repair the wobble trap are in and the necessary repairs will be made.
- A detailed discussion was held regarding the previously discussed exterior repairs and interior meeting room and bathroom remodeling of the clubhouse. Ronny Brown reported that no roof leaks were noticed after recent heavy rains. Brian Miller and Jeremy Abbott inspected the gutter and drainage concerns and advised that downspouts with extended drainage lines are needed to direct roof water run-off away from the footing and foundation. Discussion followed regarding the need to remove any water lines from the exterior wall and relocate or discard the current holding tank and plumb the lines from the well directly to the bathroom areas with a smaller tank. Pex type pipe will be used to minimize potential freeze damage. Meeting room and bathroom interior options were discussed at length regarding wall and ceiling renovations. It was decided that fiber-cement type panels would offer the best long-term performance on the meeting room and bathroom walls and that a suspended ceiling would be the best ceiling option. Further, it was decided the meeting room/lobby partition wall be moved back to the hallway area and increase the meeting room size in order to accommodate larger meeting attendance. A motion was made and passed to proceed with the proposed repairs and revisions. Brian Miller was advised to proceed with the needed exterior drainage work. Jeremy Abbott will try to secure a set of bathroom vanities at a reduced cost to the club. Steve Roe will secure material costs for the fiber cement panels and contact a ceiling contractor to secure costs for the ceiling. Ronny Brown advised he would be able to secure troffer style light fixtures at little to no cost to the club.

### New Business:

- To those using the clubhouse and indoor range facilities, please leave the circuit breakers on which provide heat to the bathrooms for freeze prevention.
- Harold Wilson advised the recent benchrest matches have been successful and well attended and requested additional dates to shoot throughout the winter months. Dates were granted.
- Ronny Brown advised the annual All Around Match would be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturdays in January for the rifle event, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturdays in February for the pistol and shotgun events.
- Ronny Brown advised the 3 Gun TGAC matches will be held the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday each month. Ronny Brown will take over Match Director duties for these matches for the immediate future.
- Randy Clark requested and was granted use of the range facilities on December 13<sup>th</sup> for a CCW class.



- Keith Harper requested and was granted use of the range facilities on March 14<sup>th</sup> for a training/CCW class.
- Jeremy Abbott advised he has a 60" pull-behind mower deck that he will donate to the club to aid in grounds maintenance. Thanks Jeremy!

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM.
