The monthly meeting of CVRP began at 7:31 PM with President Randy Clark presiding. The minutes were read and approved. The treasurers report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$21,251.07, deposits were \$982.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$272.04. Ending balance was \$21,961.03. Guests this month were Kyle Watts, 2nd meeting, Chris Benfield and Barry Brittain, third meetings. Barry was subsequently voted into membership by the club. Welcome Barry! Previous member Jason Dillard will be seeking reinstatement after attending shooting sessions with current members and getting a review of the current club rules.

Old Business : Bryan Miller will be paid \$8505 for the just completed road work, where he spread and smoothed 196 tons of gravel, along with adding a culvert at the pistol range and reinforcement of the creek bed, including resetting of the footbridge on the left side of the 100 yard range. Bryan will try to finish with the work in the area of the 200 meter firing line by the end of March.

New Business: Work parties will commence starting the second Thursday in May, and will continue each month through the summer into early fall. The first item for repair is the downed fence on the plate range. Trim Drum received club approval for the yearly paper target purchase, which is expected to be about \$1500. The membership is reminded that the club will host Riverview Sports "Vendors Day" from 9AM to 3PM on Saturday, May 3rd. Shannon will be setting up Friday afternoon and evening, May 2nd, and club members are asked to cooperate. As in the past, all members are invited to attend the event, but are asked not to bring any family or guests on that day. The .22 TSC matches are resuming with slight rule changes, now allowing bloop tubes and tuners. Blake received permission for the resumption of the black powder cartridge rifle matches starting the first Saturday in April, followed by matches in June, July, August and September. Tom Johanson requested and received permission to acquire new 8" by 3/8" armor steel plates for the plate racks at a cost of about \$400. Mike Grecko received permission to run a Concealed Carry class on March 29th. Cost will be \$75, with a \$25 discount for members and spouses. Keith Harper also has permission to run a concealed carry class scheduled for April 26th, and is holding 4 spots open for members at a \$25 discount. The TGAC 3 gun matches were approved by the membership to be held on the pistol ranges the 1st Saturdays in April, June, July, August and September. Cable trenching through the parking lot will take place Friday, March 14th starting at about 9AM.
