The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club president, Randy Clark. The April meeting minutes were read and approved. The April 2014 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$16,563.23, deposits were \$18,469.30 and disbursements for the month totaled \$3,710.75. Ending balance was \$31,321.78. Guests this month were Houston Myers, 1st meeting; and Chris Benfield, 4th meeting. Subsequently, Mr. Benfield was voted into the club. Welcome Chris!

Old Business:

- Tim Drum advised that targets have been purchased and delivered with several new options available for both centerfire and rimfire shooting.
- Tim Drum further noted the repairs to the steel pistol targets are in process but not yet completed.
- The parking lot expansion at the 200 yard firing line is now completed and looks great with plenty of graveled parking for events at the 200 yard line.

New Business:

- Randy Clark addressed the members present regarding an incident where an individual(s) has been using the new 2700 target frames for shot shell patterning with damage resulting to the frame. Footage from the CCTV cameras was reviewed for range entry during the timeframe of the event. A member did come forward after the meeting and the event was discussed. This practice will quickly destroy the frames and must not be repeated.
- Tim Drum advised that damage has occurred to the new target posts at the 100 yard line due to persons shooting the posts intentionally. The posts will be repaired and further investigation into the damage will be done using the CCTV video.
- Shannon Lyndon of Riverview Sports reminded the club that the range day/shooting event sponsored by Riverview Sports will be May 3rd with 12 manufacturers present. Set up day will be Friday May 2nd at 4 PM. CVRPC members only may attend the event.
- Work party days will again begin starting Thursday, May 8th beginning at 4 PM.
- Randy Clark advised the membership present of an injury resulting from an accidental discharge occurring at an event in Lenoir, NC recently. In consideration, discussion was held regarding the possible need for a Liability Waiver to be signed by all competitors and witnesses at matches held on CVRPC property. A draft of the waiver document was read to the membership. Some modifications will be made to the document and the subject will be reviewed again at the June meeting.



- Skeet inventory is running low and it is time to re-order. Ronny Brown will schedule the re-order and delivery. Additionally, the boxes of skeet in the low house have a tendency to deteriorate. Occasional rotating of the boxes is recommended.
- Norm Goelzer advised the April F-Class match was rained out and will be rescheduled for November 15th.
- Ronny Brown advised there will be no TGAC match on Saturday, May 3rd.
- The Bunker Hill FFA Wildlife Hunter Safety Team recently competed in Ellerbe, NC. The club would like to recognize Neill and Duane Sipe for their work with the Bunker Hill youth.
- Keith Harper requested the date of June 8th for a CCW class using the range facility. The request was approved.
- Due to the increasing amount of CCW and other “classes” being held on the range property, it was decided that a committee study class frequency and range usage. A committee consisting of Sam Birchfield, Larry Cline, and Randy Clark will look into this and report back to the membership.
- Ronny Brown advised that he met with a tree cutting contractor regarding the trees at the skeet range. The contractor declined the job as he stated the amount of trees to be cut were insufficient.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:18 PM.
