## November 6, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club vice-president, Sam Birchfield. The October meeting minutes were read and approved. The October, 2014 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$22,452.43, deposits were \$705.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$401.86. Ending balance was \$22,755.57. ### Old Business:

- The steel plate rack is awaiting two additional plates to complete the repairs however it is fully functional.
- Tim Drum advised that Bob Metz has ordered to parts to repair the wobble trap and that a cover is being designed to aid in weatherproofing.

### New Business:

- G.W. Northam advised the NC State High Power Championship match raised \$564.89 in revenue for the club.
- Lonnie Hagadorn requested and was granted permission to hold the CVRPC Smallbore Bullseye Winter League matches beginning January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015 and continuing through mid-March. See Lonnie Hagadorn or the club website for more details.
- Executive Range Officer Tim Drum advised all prospective new members that the next walk around orientation would be on December 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM.
- Tim Drum noted that Duke Power has requested the club remove a number of trees which are encroaching on the power lines between the 200 yd range and the skeet range. It was advised to wait until the leaves complete falling to make vision and cleanup easier.
- Steve Roe advised the last .22 TSC match of the year will be held on November 8th.
- Mike Guffie advised the members present of an ammunition warning involving Independence brand 9mm Luger, 115 grain ammo. The box is marked standard however the rounds are +P and could pose a danger in handguns not capable of handling +P pressure.
- Steve Roe addressed the membership regarding the “Building and Grounds” committee initial findings regarding the current condition of the exterior and interior of the clubhouse. The members were made aware of multiple water related issues with the roof, walls, and foundation. In order to maintain the integrity of the structure, it was decided to move forward with securing estimated costs for the exterior repairs and interior meeting room and bathroom revisions. The committee will estimate the costs and report back at the December meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:12 PM.
