The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club president, Randy Clark. The May meeting minutes were read and approved. The May, 2015 Treasurer's report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$28, 841.43, deposits were \$12,174.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$716.30. Ending balance was \$40,299.13. Guests this month were Mike Sigmon – 1st meeting; Reggie Sigmon, Mark Sigmon, and Tom McReary – 2nd meeting; and David Gibbs 3rd meeting. David Gibbs was voted into membership. Welcome David!

Old Business:

- Clubhouse / Meeting room remodel status: Steve Roe advised the electrical service panel has been changed out, new lighting wired and hung, the first coat of paint applied, with trim painting and ceiling work expected to begin next week. Work will continue each Monday night until completion; with the meeting room and lobby completion expected in early July. Work on the bathroom remodel will begin in the fall, likely September or October.
- Bryan Miller requested permission to continue with the creek bank grading and additional dumping and application of concrete along the creek banks to deter future washing. Estimated cost of \$1200.00 for trackhoe work. Motion passed. Thanks Bryan for your efforts on this project.
- Clubhouse area parking: Bryan Miller is excavating dirt in this area at no cost to the club. This will aid greatly in parking lot expansion at the clubhouse.
- Ronny Brown advised the clubhouse roof will need another coat of roof sealer to help prevent further leakage.
- Randy Clark reminded the members that when shooting steel targets on the Pistol range, straight wall pistol rounds and rimfire rounds ONLY are to be used. No bottleneck cartridges are allowed for use on steel at the pistol range.
- Tim Drum discussed the possibility of long-term plans to purchase AR400 or AR500 targets that can withstand center fire bottleneck rounds for the pistol range. This will be further discussed at future meetings.

New Business:

- Tim Drum brought several new injection molded chairs to the meeting which were obtained at no cost to the club. Tim advised that additional chairs can be purchased for \$5 each. A motion was made and passed to purchase up to 100 additional chairs.
- It was discussed and recommended that once the new chairs are delivered the older wooden and upholstered chairs will be donated or discarded.
- Ronny Brown advised the Three Gun Action Challenge match will be held on Saturday, June 6th.
- George Northam advised the 300 yard F-Class match will be held Saturday, June 6th.
- Steve Roe advised the .22 TSC "360" match will be held Saturday, June 13th with targets from 50 to 300 yards and 5 stages. Payout will be through 5th place and approximately \$1000 in doorprizes are to be given away, with a cookout to follow after the match.
- Keith Harper reminded the membership that he will hold a CCW class on Saturday, June 6th at 8:30 AM.
- A work party will be held on Thursday June 11th with mowing of the various ranges needed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 PM.
