The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club president, Randy Clark. The February meeting minutes were read and approved. The February, 2015 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$22,822.31, deposits were \$1,517.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$280.00. Ending balance was \$24,059.31. Guests this month were David Gibbs – 1st meeting.

Old Business:

- Clubhouse/Meeting Room Remodel:
 - Steve Roe advised the siding material is currently a BLX in Charlotte and will work with Al Pine and Neill Sipe regarding delivery to CVRPC. Steve Roe and Al Pine to coordinate additional material (lumber and insulation) delivery.
 - Jeremy Abbott advised the plumbing revisions have been completed with new supply lines, tank, and vanities installed and operational. Straw has been placed on the ground where digging was performed. The old tank is available if someone is in need.
 - A new roof leak was discovered inside the pistol range and needs looking into to determine the source and necessary repairs.
 - A work party is scheduled for Monday March 9th at 6:00 PM to begin work on the meeting room remodel.

- Harold Wilson will coordinate the building of the new benches and drop-down blinds at the 300 yard line. Four new benches are to be constructed.

New Business:

- It was reported the lighting inside the storage building at the 100 yard line is in need of repair; potentially new bulbs and or ballasts.
- A motion was passed regarding the purchase of material for additional drop down blinds at the 300 yard line.
- Harold Wilson reported some of the target frames from the 300 yard line are missing. It was advised to store the frames inside the 100 yard line building and secure when not in use.
- The Riverview Sports Manufacturer’s Day Shoot is scheduled for May 2nd. This shoot is for CVRPC members only.
- Ronny Brown advised the TGAC Match scheduled for May 2nd will be cancelled.
- Tim Drum advised the storage building at the 100 yard line is in need of a clean-up in order to make additional storage space. Tim Drum, George Northam, and Sam Birchfield will review the items in need of disposal.
- Ronny Brown advised the local sawmiller will not come and pick up the downed logs on site due to insufficient quantity. However the sawmiller will purchase the logs from CVRPC if we can haul the logs to the mill. It was agreed to sell the logs to the mill.
- Thanks go out to Gary Houser and Ronny Brown for cleaning up the debris from the fallen tree and resulting damage at the pistol range.
- The damage to the shed at the pistol range will be assessed in the coming weeks and a determination made regarding repairs.



- The membership is reminded the April meeting will be held on Thursday, April 9th at Catawba United Methodist Church at 7:00PM.
- Don Alexander advised he will not be able to run the Black Powder Cartridge Match in 2015. If anyone is interested in continuing and running these matches please contact Don Alexander.
- Steve Roe advised the .22 TSC matches will begin on April 11th and continue the 2nd Saturday each month through October.
