## September 3, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club president, Randy Clark. The August meeting minutes were read and approved. The August, 2015 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$31,170.51, deposits were \$3,819.97 and disbursements for the month totaled \$1,133.84. Ending balance was \$33,856.64. Guests this month were Dan Fox, Tim Scarr, and Eric Zimmerman – 1<sup>st</sup> meeting, Mike Sigmon and Ryan Burns, – 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting. Mike Sigmon and Ryan Burns were voted into membership. Welcome gentlemen!

### Old Business:

- Bob Metts advised the restoration of the signage on the front of the clubhouse is progressing and should be completed soon.
- Tim Drum advised that he has met with a concrete contractor regarding the indoor range floor concrete and a quote of \$6000 has been secured. Discussion followed regarding lead and dust management. A motion was made and passed to proceed with this project.
- Steve Roe advised the By Laws have been updated to reflect the recent membership total changes and the membership application form has also been revised.
- George Northam informed the membership that a step ladder has been purchased. An extension ladder will be purchased in the near future.
- Ronny Brown advised the membership that the recently purchased 4 wheeler was located and purchased through Craig’s List.
- Ronny Brown advised the 50 Yard line at the pistol range has been repaired. Thanks to Ronny and Gary Houser for the repair work.
- Ronny Brown advised that he has investigated the cost of a replacement bush-hog mower. A new unit is in excess of \$2000 and as such he will continue to look for a quality used mower.
- Steve Roe advised that he will meet with the phone company service rep and request an inside drop be installed.
- George Northan stated the modifications to the old chalkboard did not sufficiently work and that a new dry erase board was purchased.
- Tim Drum reminded the membership present the range’s steel targets must not be shot with steel core ammo.
- Tim Drum initiated a discussion regarding the raising and extension of the pistol range berms. Tim advised the increased height (up to 12’) of the berms would allow for additional matches and potentially additional long term income for the club. A discussion followed regarding potential modifications and the earthmoving required. A motion was made and passed. Tim will discuss the project with Bryan Miller and secure a cost for the modifications.
- Randy Clark advised the 911 address sign has been installed at the club entrance.
- Randy Clark advised (for Eric Jones) that Eric will conduct a CPR class at either his home or at the local Fire Department and needs to know the number of members planning to attend.

- George Northam advised the F-Class match will be held on September 5<sup>th</sup> beginning at 8:30 AM.
- Harold Wilson advised the 300 Yard Benchrest score match will be held on September 26<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 AM.
- Al Pine stated that he left a shooting bag on the 100 yard line recently. If anyone knows of this bags whereabouts please contact Al Pine.
