February 4, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club president, Randy Clark. The January meeting minutes were read and approved. The January, 2016 Treasurer’s report was read and accepted. Balance brought forward was \$24,094.18, deposits were \$1,829.00 and disbursements for the month totaled \$5,086.48. Ending balance was \$20,836.70. Guests this month were: Mike Wilson, Randy Guymer, and Scott Waddell, 2nd meeting, Michael Hollar, and Charles Hardy – 3rd meeting. Michael Hollar was voted into membership.

Old Business:

- Randy Clark advised the target frames from H&H have arrived and have been installed at the pistol range. Thanks go out to Randy and Gary Houser for working with the new frames. Also, the frames ordered for individual purchase are in for pick up.
- John Grimes updated the members present regarding our current property insurance coverage. Our current coverage for the clubhouse is limited at \$75,000.00 and the 100 yard line building at \$15,000.00. It was agreed to increase the coverage to match the appraised value at \$250,000.00 and \$20,000.00 respectively. This will constitute an increase in our premium rates from \$1,045.00 to approximately \$1,900.00.
- The members using the indoor range during winter months are once again reminded to turn the bathroom heating units to the “Low” setting to avoid the potential of fire hazard.
- Randy Clark updated the membership on the status of the suspects in the theft of club property last fall. Randy met with the D.A.’s office representative and completed an Impact statement regarding the loss. If the suspect is found guilty, additional recovery damages will be sought. The next court date is set for May, 2016.
- George Northam reminded the membership that an F-Class matche will be held March 19th.

New Business

- John Grimes has posted a revised “Dues Sheet” in the clubhouse. Additionally, this will be posted on the cvrp.org website.
- The CVRPC annual meeting will be held at Catawba Methodist Church on April, 7th.
- Keith Harper advised the membership that all Club members are eligible for two, \$30 CCW class certificates.
- Tim Drum advised the barrels at the Pistol range are not trash cans, rather stage props. These barrels will be marked accordingly going forward.
- Club member Bill Arney has been in the CCU at Baptist Hospital in Winston-Salem. Our prayers are will you Bill and we wish you a speedy recovery.
- Any club members who may be traveling in or through VA are reminded that VA’s concealed carry laws have recently changed. Please visit www.vcdl.org for additional information.
- The Executive Committee recommendations addressing range training and education for all members were presented to the members present. These recommendations were passed and adopted as follows:



In an effort to eliminate any safety issues and property damage, and in an effort to bring clarity to all CVRPC members, additional steps are suggested by the Board as follows:

1. Prior to receiving a gate key for 2016-2017 membership year, all members must complete a Range Training walk through with the CVRPC Executive Range Officer or the Range Officer. These sessions will begin on Thursday, April 14th and continue each Thursday evening through April and May, ending June 2nd. These sessions will be done in groups/squads of 10-15 members. The Range Officer and Executive Range Officer will have Range rules and Procedure Handouts for reference during the training and for future reference. The club Secretary will work with the Range Officers to generate and produce the handouts. All members must attend. There will be medical exemptions (only) if needed. A schedule of the available training dates will be posted in the clubhouse, and also on the club website. You will be responsible for working out scheduling with the club Range Officers for your specific training date. All members must complete their session prior to new keys being issued in June.
2. Additionally, we propose that a CVRPC Range Rules and Procedures video be produced. This video will be used for those who have medical conditions that prevent participating in the above mentioned training sessions. The video will also be used for continuing education on a yearly basis and will include any new or additional club rules.
3. A CVRPC "manual" is being produced and will be available in the near future. This comprehensive manual will have club historical data, and also items and documents such as the club Bylaws, and updated club rules. Once available, each club member will be required to read the manual and acknowledge all requirements therein by signature.
4. After all members have completed the Range Training, received their Rules and Procedural Handout, and completed the CVRPC manual, the occurrence of safety, procedural, and property damage infractions are anticipated to be minimized, if not eliminated. The intent and purpose of the above measures are to make CVRPC continue to be a safe facility to enjoy the shooting sports. Going forward, any member found willfully committing any safety or property damage infractions will be brought before the club in accordance with the club Bylaws for disciplinary action as recommended by the Board.
