The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by club president, Sam Birchfield. The January minutes were read and accepted. Treasurer's report was read: balance brought forward was 33,224.10, deposits were 298.00, disbursements were 494.79 with an ending balance of 33,027.31.

Old Business:

- Brian Miller reported back that EZ Pull makes a wireless system for skeet that will work with our skeet machines but not the wobble trap. This system can be triggered by voice or manually triggered. The system is \$775.00 plus taxes. A motion was made to purchase and install the system, motion passed.
- Steve Rowe reported that 17 competitors completed the rifle portion of the All Around match. Shotgun and pistol portion will be held on the 10th at 9:30.

New Business

- Wobble trap machine is broken due to damage to the main board. Tim Drum reminded the club that the wobble trap control box is weather resistant and not weather proof.
- It was brought to the club's attention that the skeet machines have not been turned off and arms released individually before the breaker was turned off. In addition, machines have not been filled up after use and hulls were left on the ground. This is disrespectful to other club members and damaging to club property. Please make sure the correct procedure is being followed when using the skeet range.
- The 4H will be at the next meeting to talk about their recent shooting competitions. Come early to meet them and show your support of youth programs.
- Ronnie Brown will report back on the venue for the annual banquet next month. Also, dues may be paid early in April at the banquet.
- Tim Drum recommended to the club that section 9E of the range rules be changed to remove a contradiction between match conditions and non-match conditions. This will be handled by the secretary and presented to the club for approval at the next meeting.
- Steve Roe reported that while targets were being painted during the All Around rifle portion a competitor ran into the yellow rope at the 100 yard range with an ATV due to lack of visibility. The narrow rope has become hazardous and a more visible barrier should be used. During discussion a member offered a gate that the club could have. Also, David Wooten offered to have sandwich board type signs made for the club.
