The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by club president, Sam Birchfield. The April minutes were read and accepted. Treasurer's report was read: balance brought forward was \$34,179.55 deposits were \$8,221.00, disbursements were \$2,536.83 with an ending balance of \$39,863.72.

Old Business:

- Wobble Trap was repaired for under \$700.00. The unused high house will be remolded to keep the wobble trap in and provide additional shooting platforms in the future.
- Club is reminded that the breaker needs to be turned off to skeet throwers as we come into thunder storm season.
- A gate has been donated to take the place of the rope at the 100 yard range. It will be installed when the hinge pipe comes in.
- The masonry work has been finished and paint is scheduled to be done by next month. Painting the club house will estimated to cost \$2800.00
- Range rules committee reported back with a proposal of update range rules. A motion was made and passed by the club to approve the updated range rules.

New Business:

- Keith Harper requested use of the pistol range for a conceal carry class. The club approved the request.
- Randy Clark requested the use of the pistol range on the second Saturday at 9 A.M May-October for Cowboy Auction match. Request was approved by the club
- Steve Roe advised that the .22 TSC match will be held in June, August and October.
- Anyone interested in taking the NRA Range Safety Officer on May 20 and May 27 class should contact Tim Drum. Class will be from 9:30am till 3pm on both days.
- Skeet League will be held this Sunday at 2pm on the skeet range.
- AR fun match will be held May 12 at the 300yard line.
- It was brought to the club that we need a 3rd range officer to help watch over the range. A motion was made and passed to instate Tom Johannsen as an additional range officer.
- Sam reported to the club that a 1985 tractor with 1000 hours has been located. It would include a bush hog, box blade and scrape blade for \$9000. A motion was made, and passed, to purchase the tractor.
- The officer committee recommended that a tax attorney should look over the club's nonprofit status. A motion was made, and passed, to hire a tax attorney to review the club's nonprofit status.
- A motion was made, and passed, to spend \$3000 on new steel to replace the aging and dangerous steel targets.
- Tim Drum reminds club members to only use approved targets on our ranges for the safety of everyone.
- Todd Miller, Rodger Shaffer, Jess Lamphere, John Webster, and Dorney Lapierre were voted into membership. Welcome new members.
